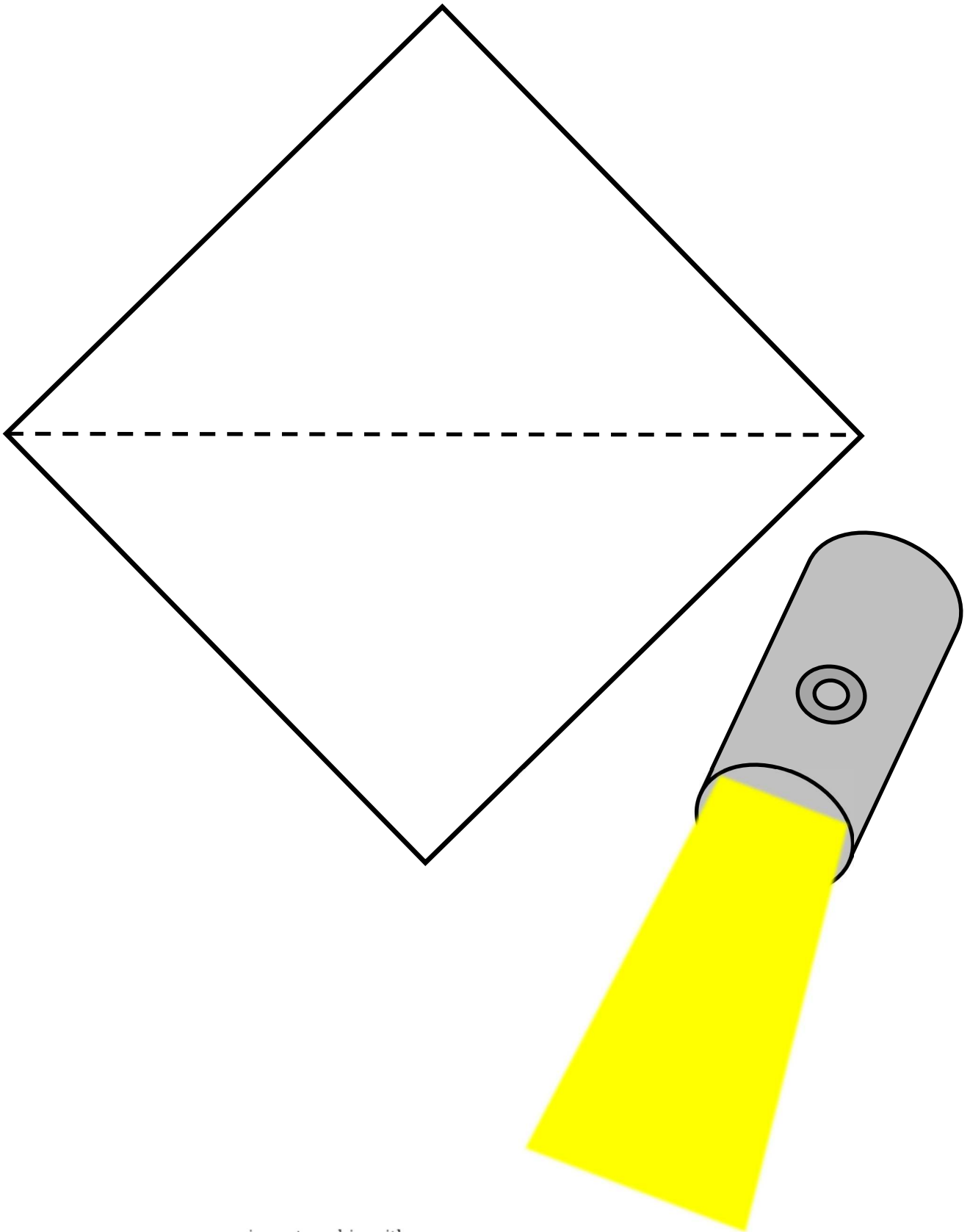


Torch Bookmark

Have a go at making this torch bookmark. It will help you to remember how important it is to be seen. You can cut out this picture below or you can use any square of paper you have.



1. Start off with a square of paper. Cut out the one on page 1 if you want to, or use any square of paper you have. Hold it in front of you like a diamond
2. Fold the bottom point up to the top point and crease along the bottom, making your square into a triangle. Fig 1.
3. Fold the tip of the top triangle down to the base of the triangle Fig 2.
4. Fold the left hand corner up, to meet the top tip of the triangle. repeat with the right hand corner. This gives you a small square with a line down the middle. Fig 3.
5. Take the left hand flap, created by step 4, unfold slightly, then tuck it behind the line (that step 3 created) that is in the middle of the square. Fig 4. Repeat with the right hand side. Fig 5
6. Turn your square round and you have your basic bookmark. Fig 6. It will sit over the corner of a page of your book. Now it is time to decorate it. Colour in the back however you wish. Then you can either cut out the torch picture or design your own and stick it/draw it on to the front two triangles (or draw your own light / torch to cut out). Make sure you only stick your light to the top two triangles, otherwise it won't sit on a page corner.

Remember—you can't see the pages of your book in the dark, just like drivers can't see you. Be bright & use a light. Be Seen to Be Safe.
